**The Kids-N-Hope Foundation Raises \$15,000 at the
Inaugural Cornhole Tournament**
*Community Event Raises Funds to Support Pediatric Music Therapy Programs
at Local Hospitals*

PHILADELPHIA– September 15, 2022 – American Heritage Credit Union (“American Heritage”) joined the Kids-N-Hope Foundation (“The Foundation”) to raise of \$15,000 during the Inaugural Cornhole Tournament, presented by Intech Construction.
